and an extensive wine list featuring rare labels and prestigious champagnes. The experience is simultaneously luxurious and deeply rooted in local tradition.





This sample itinerary covers 7 nights (Split Dubrovnik) on a private motor yacht with luxury onshore experiences. All images in this presentation feature the motor yacht QUANTUM (Sunseeker 92, 5 cabins, up to 10 guests). Yacht Charter Pricing (per week):

- Smaller motor yachts (810 guests): from approx. €33,000 €70,000 + 13% VAT + 3035% APA
- Larger motor yachts (1012 guests): from approx. €80,000 €120,000 + 13% VAT + 3035% APA
- Superyachts (12+ guests): from approx. €150,000 €280,000 + VAT + APA

QUANTUM example (yacht shown in images):

- Charter fee: approx. €70,000 / week
- 13% VAT: approx. €9,100
- 35% APA: approx. €24,500
